Project Aqua Product Specific Terms

These Product Specific Terms govern your use of Project Aqua and are incorporated by reference into the Adobe General Terms of Use ("**General Terms**") located at https://www.adobe.com/legal/terms.html. Capitalized terms not defined here have the same meaning as defined in the General Terms.

1. Intended Use and Guidance.

- 1.1 Purpose and Age-Appropriate Use. Project Aqua is designed to encourage creativity through shared experiences between parents and children and may be used by individuals of all ages, including children under the age of 13 who may use Project Aqua's child-directed portions ("Child Users"). Child Users may only access and use Project Aqua under the guidance of a parent or legal guardian ("Guardian") and only through a Guardian's Adobe account. Child Users are prohibited from creating or registering an Adobe account.
- **1.2 Guardian Role and Access Requirements for Children.** Use of Project Aqua by a Child User is permitted only if the Guardian: (i) is at least 18 years of age and is authorized to supervise Child Users; (ii) has registered for an individual Adobe ID in accordance with the General Terms; (iii) has reviewed and acknowledged how Project Aqua collects and processes children's data in the Project Aqua Children's Privacy Notice described in Section 2; and (iv) agrees to manage the Child User's access to and use of Project Aqua.
- **1.3 Guardian Involvement and Access.** Adobe relies on Guardian involvement to help ensure Project Aqua is used appropriately. Guardians are expected to actively manage how Child Users interact with Project Aqua. If Project Aqua is being accessed or used in ways that do not align with its intended use, Adobe may restrict, suspend, or terminate access to Project Aqua in order to maintain a safe and responsible environment.
